Description:	Formalin-fixed normal human adult brain tissue block (cerebellum). Region of brain subject to availability. 0.1 g is a sufficient amount of tissue for approximately 40 slides of average section thickness (5 μ m).

Cause of Death:	Motor vehicle accident
Viral Serology:	Negative for HIV, HBV and HCV.
Applications:	Formalin-fixed tissue is useful for a number of applications including specific application such as immunohistochemistry (IHC), in situ hybridization (ISH) and fluorescence hybridization (FISH). Certain tissue types require special protocols to eliminate endogenous biotin, peroxidase or autofluorescence.
Format:	Formalin-fixed tissue block
Storage:	Maintain at room temperature. Stable for years.
Notes:	All tissue is examined and diagnosed by a licensed pathologist and is ethically obtained. Sex and age of the donor is lot dependent.
